Our awardee is an accomplished individual. He is a Master in Business Administration from the De La Salle University-Manila. He also finished BS in Commerce major in Business Management from the same university in addition to his BS Electrical Engineering studies at the University of the Philippines-Diliman. But what makes him different from other professionals is the fact that he is a PCS alumnus having finished his basic education in this institution.
